Regulations of credits about graduates	<p>(1). Students must acquire at least 30 credits:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Required courses of the Institute: 4 semesters of “Music Colloquium” (0 credit). 2. Required courses of composition and performance group: 2 credits of “Introduction to Music Research” Required courses of musicology group: 3 credits of “Theory and Methods in Musicology” and 4 credits of “Musicology Practicum.” <p>(2). Supplementary and remedial courses:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students must take the music theory test at the start of their study; those failing the test must take “Music Theory” and additional 2 to 4 credits of assigned courses. 2. Students of the Composition and Performance Divisions must take additional 4 credits of “Music History,” unless exempted by equivalent courses. 3. Students majoring in Piano must take 2 credits of “Instrument Study: Harpsichord (Minor),” unless exempted by equivalent courses. 4. Students of the Composition Division must take 2 credits of “Instrument Study: Qin (Minor),” unless exempted by equivalent courses. 5. These credits will not be counted toward graduation requirements. <p>(3). Composition Division: Students must take at least 30 credits:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. 10 credits from required courses of the Division: 8 credits of major and 2 credits of “Introduction to Music Research.” 2. At least 20 credits of elective courses: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (a) At least 2 credits from the Music Theory category. (b) At least 2 credits from the Musicology category. (c) At least 6 credits from the Composition category. (d) Students majoring in Electronic Music or New Music Theatre: at least 3 credits from courses of external institutes as approved by the advising professors as well as the director of the Institute. 3. Credits of major over and above that will not be counted. <p>(4). Performance Division: Students must take at least 30 credits:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. 16 credits from required courses of the Division: 12 credits of “Advanced Instruction” in one’s majoring instrument, 2 credits of “Introduction to Music Research,” and 2 credits of “Chamber Music.” 2. At least 14 credits of elective courses: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (a) At least 2 credits from the Music Theory category. (b) At least 2 credits from the Musicology category. (c) At least 2 credits from the Performance Seminar category. (d) At least 2 credits of other courses. 3. “Advanced Instruction” courses exceeding 12 credits and “Chamber Music” exceeding 4 credits will not be counted toward graduation requirements. <p>(5). Musicology Division: Students must take at least 30 credits:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. 7 credits from required courses of the Division: 3 credits of “Theory and Methods in Musicology.” and 4 credits of “Musicology Practicum.” 2. At least 23 credits of elective courses: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (a) At least 2 credits for Music Theory courses. (b) At least 12 credits for Musicology courses. (c) At least 6 credits from courses of external institutes as approved by the advising professors as well as the director of the Institute. 3. “Musicology Practicum” exceeding 4 credits will not be counted toward graduation requirements.
